I initiate the report with the success of our alumni in different fields, which makes us proud, and is the evidence, of what IIS has been able to achieve, over the years.

Akshat Jain , our alumnus of batch 2014 secured Second Rank in Civil Service Exam 2018, making his Alma Mater proud.

Akshat Goyal of batch 2017 secured All India Rank 1 in the Chartered Accountant Intermediate Award Exam May 2019.

Coming to academics, IIS had excellent board results for CBSE class 12, with Nandini Joshi as the school and Humanities topper at 97.4% and 61 of our students securing 90% and above. Also 28 students secured cent % marks in different subjects.

Our petals also proved their mettle, at the All India Secondary School Examination- 2019, where Labdhi Jain was the topper having secured 98.2%, and 77 of our students securing 90% and above, and 22 students secured cent % marks in different subjects.

Our scholars from International board too celebrated their applaudable results, with Mili Garg as the school topper, in the Cambridge Assessment International Education Examinations. 5 students secured an A* in different subjects.

Navneedhi Meena is the topper of the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme with 40 grade points. 7 students out of 12, secured 7 grade points in different subjects and 5 students, secured grade 'A' in Extended Essays, which is exemplary.

We are proud to announce that our student- Nandini Bhargava, has been awarded the prestigious Vanijya Shree Award 2019 with a cash prize of 10,000/s by the International Commerce Teachers Foundation.

Riya Jain participated in the knowledge Quiz organized by Dainik Bhasker, and was one of the 5 selected students from Rajasthan who interacted with the honorable Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Shri Ashok Gehlot ji, in a Question- Answer session.

At the Bharat ko Jano Quiz, organized by the Vishwa Hindu Parishad our students reached the district level, where the seniors came out with flying colors.

An overwhelming response from the students for the Wild Wisdom Quiz- is a proof that true IISians are always willing to explore new arenas. At the state level, our middle wing students bagged the second position, and they further made us proud, when their exemplary conduct throughout the competition, resulted in them being adjudged, as the best outstation team, from amongst 40 participating teams. This is an example of disciplined IISians never forgetting to uphold the values instilled in them.

Our students excelled in the literary arena as well. Three students of our school participated in the Debating Workshop organized by the Indian Schools Debating Society and got a special mention. Priyal Sharma was also adjudged the best speaker for the motion.

IISians leave their mark -be it the extremely competitive debate - Verbattle or be it competing against the best of minds at MNIT- our students have always come out at

the top. Their securing the third position at the Flair Fest in History Enactment Competition is a remarkable achievement.

It is noteworthy to mention, that 18 of our students have cleared the prestigious NSTSE and have cleared French Olympiad too, at the junior as well as the senior level.

IISians participation, in the Solar Student Ambassador Workshop organized by IIT Bombay, is a proof that at IIS, sky is truly the limit for those, willing to try.

18th July witnessed a new chapter in the history of IIS when the nation's pride, the monumental tricolor was hoisted in the school's premises by the Honorable Guests Sh. Bhanwar Singh Bhati, Minister of State for higher education and Dr Subhash Garg, Minister of State for technical education.

IIS also marked the 150th Birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi by organizing and participating in competitions organized in his honor. Priyal Sharma of our school received a cash prize from Dainik Bhaskar for having written an, award winning article, for the newspaper.

In an effort to give our students the best of choices and opportunities to select from, for their under graduate programmes, together with university counseling fairs, IIS always encourage students to experience SAT through the PSAT exam. Our school has been a SAT Study Centre and I am proud to share that this year has added another feather in our

cap with IIS now being the recognized **SAT Exam Centre**, as well.

The summer program for International Wing student was a grand success with visits, experiential learning, innovative methods of Teaching & Learning, fun activities and a lot more in terms of quality education with innovative techniques.

The international wing at IIS took another leap forward this year when CLSP students had their first exposure to the MUN, with their engaging and involved participation in the 1st chapter of **IIS Junior MUN**.

The international wing also went one step further in inculcating not only skills, but values too with the introduction of the **Honour Till Club** in school, to celebrate and practice the most important virtue,- honesty in every walk of life.

Keeping pace with changing trends IIS has taken a lead in introducing its students to Artificial Intelligence. Our school is amongst the first 60 schools of India chosen by CBSE to be a part of a pilot project on Artificial Intelligence.

I am happy to share the most recent addition which aims to create thinking minds.- the **innovation hub** set up in collaboration with IAPT under the able guidance of Prof Y.K Vijay.

The school also has a registered **VIPNET Science Club** aptly named "Avani Rakshak" and has taken another step forward with the set up of the Govt of India supported project **Atal Tinkering Lab.**

This year also saw an introduction to Technology Education and Design, in an altogether different way, when students formed their own TED ED club, with the aim to hone public speaking skills and to generate awareness on issues of global and national importance.

We believe, instilling the sportsmanship spirit in students from a young age goes a long way, as a sportsman today will definitely be a better engineer, doctor or a civil servant tomorrow, possessing the high values, learnt on sports fields.

It was IIS everywhere in the medal list of various sports events organized by prestigious organizations like School Games Federation of India, CBSE West Zone Clusters, PIE Olympics, Rajasthan Athletics Association and many more.

Our Students brought laurels to school by bringing home gold, silver and bronze medals and securing positions in sports like Bad Minton, Table Tennis, Athletics, Swimming, Taekwondo Long Jump and many more.

I am proud of our student Suhasi Verma who has 7th position in All India Badminton Ranking and has secured 1st position 15 times in various Badminton Tournaments. She has also represented Rajasthan Badminton Team as a Captain and has played Nationals 5 times.

Our swimming champ Priyanka Rajput has 12 medals to her credit and mostly golds in them.

Seepika Saxena of our school has been awarded the best shooter award at the State level Rifle Shooting.

Kripa Chaturvedi won us gold in the Long Jump and is going to participate in CBSE Nationals.

In various athletic events- Mansi Jain, Susmita Seth and Mokshda Raj were the champions.

I proudly share, that 19 out of 25, of our worthy NCC cadets have secured 'A' certificate, and cadet Copl Somesh Sharma, was declared the second best cadet of 1 RAJ Air Sqn NCC.
