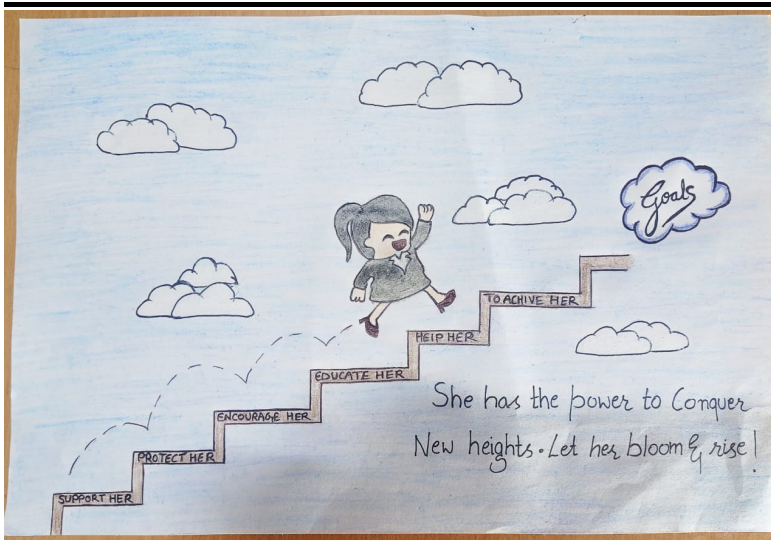


National Girl Child Day 2022
