The IB is an academically challenging and balanced programme of education that prepares students for success at the University and life beyond. It shares a common philosophy – a commitment to high quality, challenging, international education that IIB believes is important for our students. This is a two year pre university course for the students of ages 16 to 19 years which is valued and recognized by all the leading universities around the world. Statistically speaking there are more than 718,000 IB students at 2634 schools in 135 countries.

The International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.
