

Examination Policy 2022-23

Classes (1 & 2), (3 to 5)

For classes 1 & 2 promotion is granted on the basis of continuous and comprehensive evaluation in the form of formative and summative assessments spread over two terms. Only grades are awarded.

- Internal Assessment 25 marks
- Term end Assessment 25 marks
