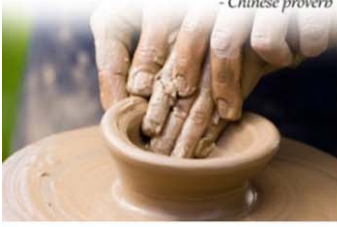
## Basant Panchami

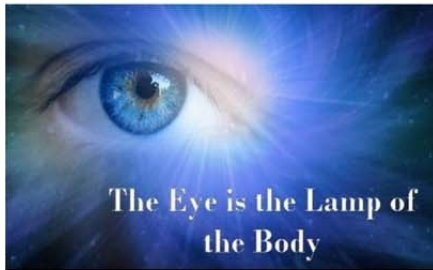

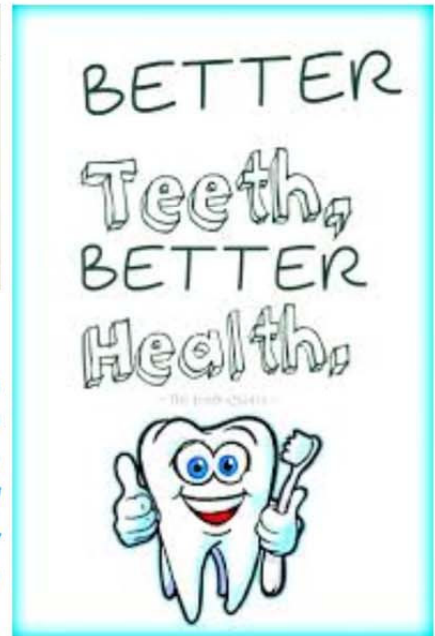

## Assembly of Excellence

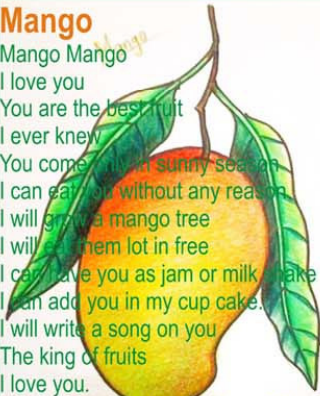

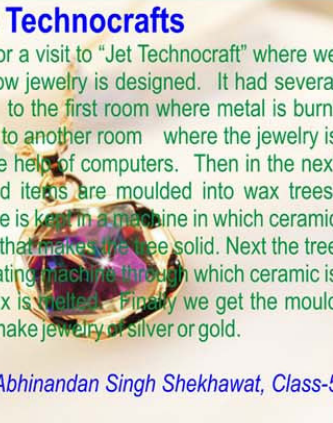

### Visit to Jet Technocrafts

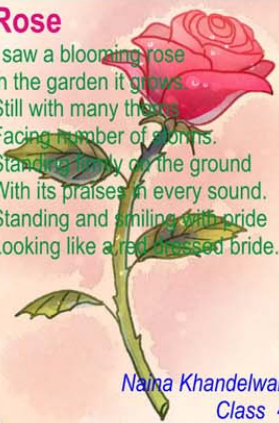

Then we went to another room where the jewelry is designed with the help of computers. Then in the next unit the designed items are moulded into wax trees. After that wax tree is kept in a machine in which ceramic powder is mixed that makes the tree solid. Next the tree is placed into heating machine through which ceramic is removed and wax is melted.
