
We would like to inform you that the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has introduced new guidelines w.r.t. class X – Board Exam – 2026.

Sharing with you the key points as mentioned in the CBSE's recent circular regarding Two Board Examinations in class X from 2026 examinations.

- Based on NEP – 2020, CBSE is implementing two opportunities for Board Exam – a Main Exam in Mid – February to Mid – March and an Optional Improvement exam in the month of May.
- It is mandatory for all students to appear in the first/Main Board Examination.
- All those students who pass the 1st/Main Board Exam may choose to re-take upto three subjects (out of Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Languages) in the 2nd/Improvement exam to improve scores.
- Students failing or absent in 3 or more subjects in the 1st/Main exam cannot take the 2nd/Improvement exam.
- Those declared Compartment in the 1st/Main exam in ≤ 2 subjects will be allowed to appear in the 2nd exam under the Category – Compartment.
- Internal Assessment will be conducted by the school only once before the 1st/Main Board Exam.
- Students declared pass by the replacement of subjects can also appear in the 2nd exam to improve in the failing subject.
- Both exams will be conducted on the full syllabus meant for the year.
- Result of 1st exam will be declared in May and for the 2nd exam in the month of June.
- Performance of 1st/Main exam will be made available in the Digilocker. Passing Document will be issued to all the students after the result for 2nd/Improvement exam is declared. Merit Certificates will also be issued only after the 2nd exam.
- Facilities of Photocopy, Verification and Re-evaluation will be available only after declaration of result of 2nd examination, for both the examinations i.e. Main and 2nd examination.
- Students not qualified in the main examination will be allowed provisional admission in class XI and based on the result of the 2nd examination, their admission will be confirmed.
