# Life Skills


## Good Touch and Bad Touch




# MATH . MAZE

## Reflection: My first **Youth Parliament**

Stepping into the Vidhan Sabha for the first time wasn't just about entering a historic building, it felt like walking into the heartbeat of democracy. I wasn't just a visitor that day, I was a participant, a voice among many ready to be heard.

When I was first selected to attend the Youth Parliament, I was excited while also nervous, but the moment I sat in those rows, mic in front of me, facing a sea of young passionate minds just like mine, something clicked.

Speaking in the Vidhan Sabha felt surreal, my words weren't just sentences. I was sharing thoughts, raising questions and challenging norms. I realised the power of voice and the weight that comes with having the freedom to express. Every debate, every interjection, every applause or disagreement was a reminder that democracy isn't abstract, it's alive, messy and beautiful.

Beyond the speeches and formalities, this experience taught me something more profound: that change doesn't start in headlines or history books, it begins with conversations- raw, respectful and relentless. It begins when we, the youth, stop waiting to be invited and start taking space.

I walked out of Vidhan Sabha that day not just feeling proud- but empowered because for the first time, I didn't just witness democracy, I experienced it, and I contributed to it.
