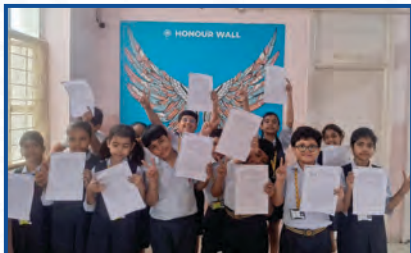


# हिन्दी सुलेख प्रतियोगिता

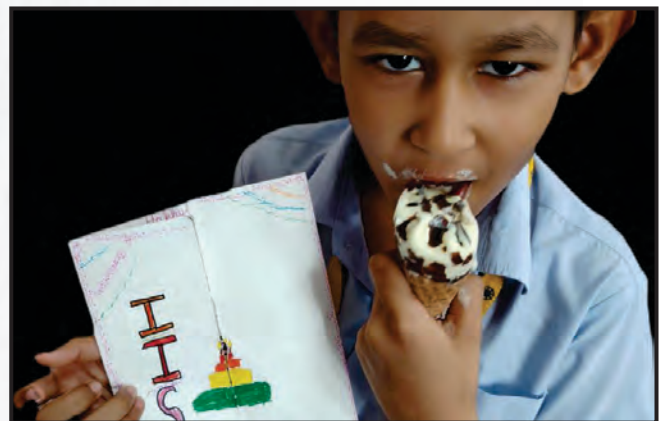

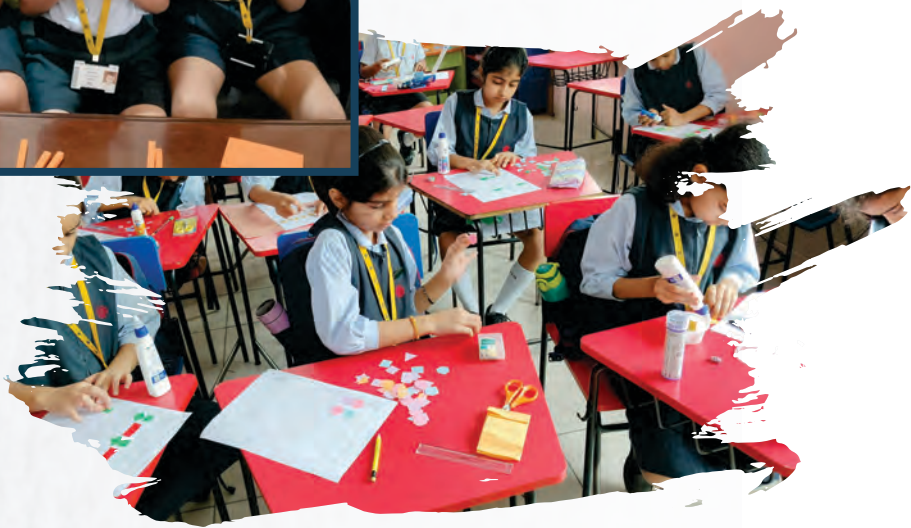
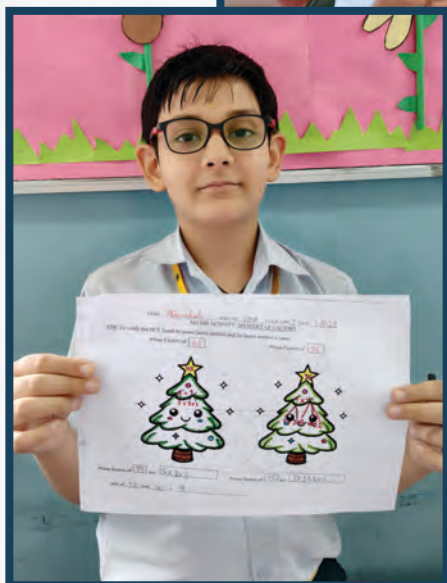

# Marathon for a Cause

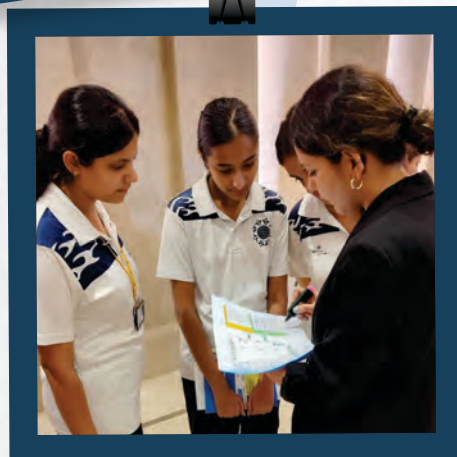

The “**Plantation Drive**” held for the Junior Wing saw little babies move around enthusiastically with

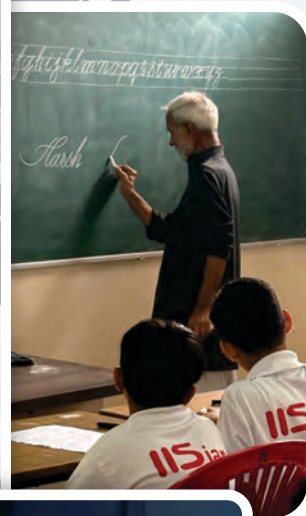
Garden Sets, sowing plants to give momentum to the Green Revolution. They are our little ambassadors sensitising the seniors on the significance of planting trees.

The DPC, Mukta Khandelwal ma'am thanked both guests and motivated everyone to continue practicing for better results.





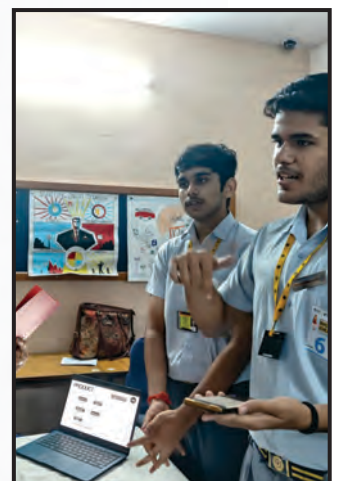
# IISians Win Laurels at Inter-School Competitions

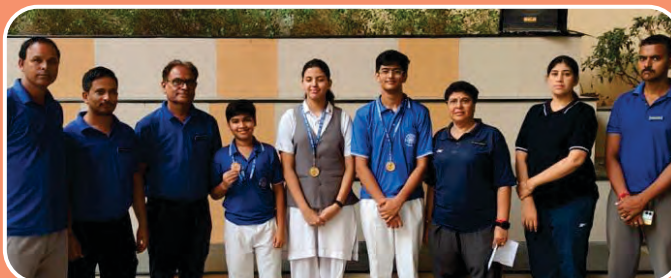
