As part of our ongoing effort to guide students in making informed academic and career choices, the school organised an interactive session for Grade 9 students on **"Skills Identification and Career Exploration"** delivered by **Mr Madhusudan Joshi**.

The objective of the session was to help students:

- Understand what *skills* are and how they differ from *knowledge* and *ability*.
- Recognize the importance of developing both **hard** (technical/academic) and **soft** (interpersonal) skills.
- Reflect on their personal strengths through a self-assessment activity called **"My Skill Map,"** where they identified what they enjoy doing, what they are good at, and how those skills can contribute to others.
- Explore how different skills connect to real-world careers.
- Learn about **free online tools** such as MyNextMove.org, CareerExplorer.com, and Onet.org, where they can further assess their interests and skills.

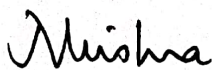
The session aimed to encourage self-awareness and introduce students to the idea that career planning begins with understanding themselves — their interests, strengths, and emerging abilities.
