As part of our ongoing career guidance program for Class X students, the school organised an interactive session yesterday on **"Career Pathway Mapping and Setting SMART Goals"**, delivered by **Mr. Madhusudan Joshi**. The objective was to help students reflect on their interests, explore future career options, and begin connecting their aspirations with informed academic choices.

During the session, students:

- Reflected on their **interests, strengths, and values** to understand themselves better.
- Explored various **career pathways** — academic, vocational, and emerging fields — highlighting how multiple routes can lead to success.
- Discussed common questions such as *"Which job is best for me?"*, *"Which career is most secure?"*, and *"Which fields offer high growth or income?"* with a focus on **balancing personal fit with practical opportunities**.
- Learnt how to set **SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Time-bound)** goals for their short-term academic and personal development.

The students have been issued a Hand-Out to record their initial ideas and draft their first SMART goal.

This activity marks the first step in a structured guidance program leading to our upcoming **Subject Selection Workshop**, scheduled for **next month**, where students will explore how their interests and goals align with subject choices for Class XI.

1. **Review your ward's filled in Hand-Out** and discuss with him/her ideas about careers and subjects.
2. **Support Open Exploration** — Students may refine their plans as they gain more information.
