

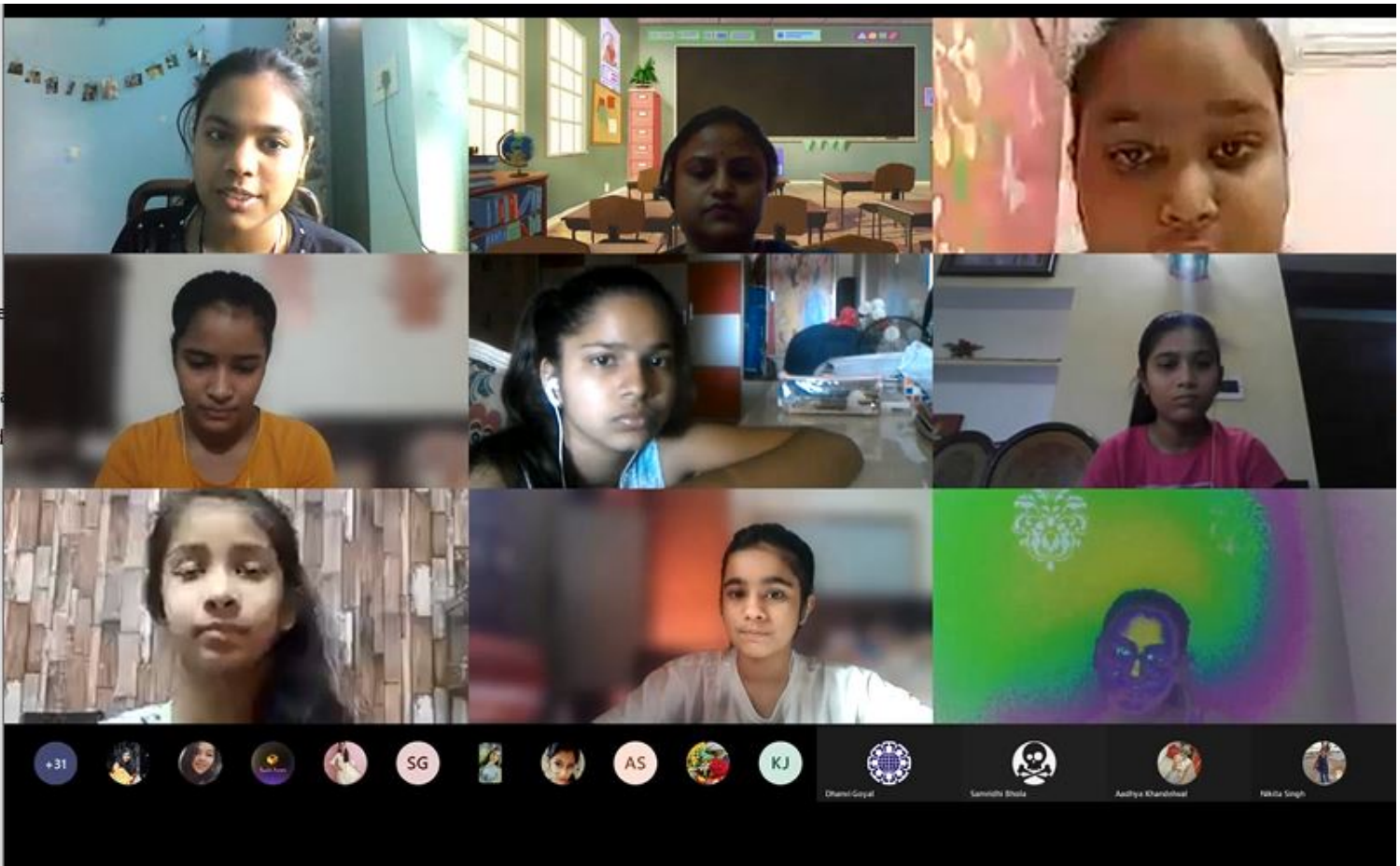
EARTH DAY 2021...
