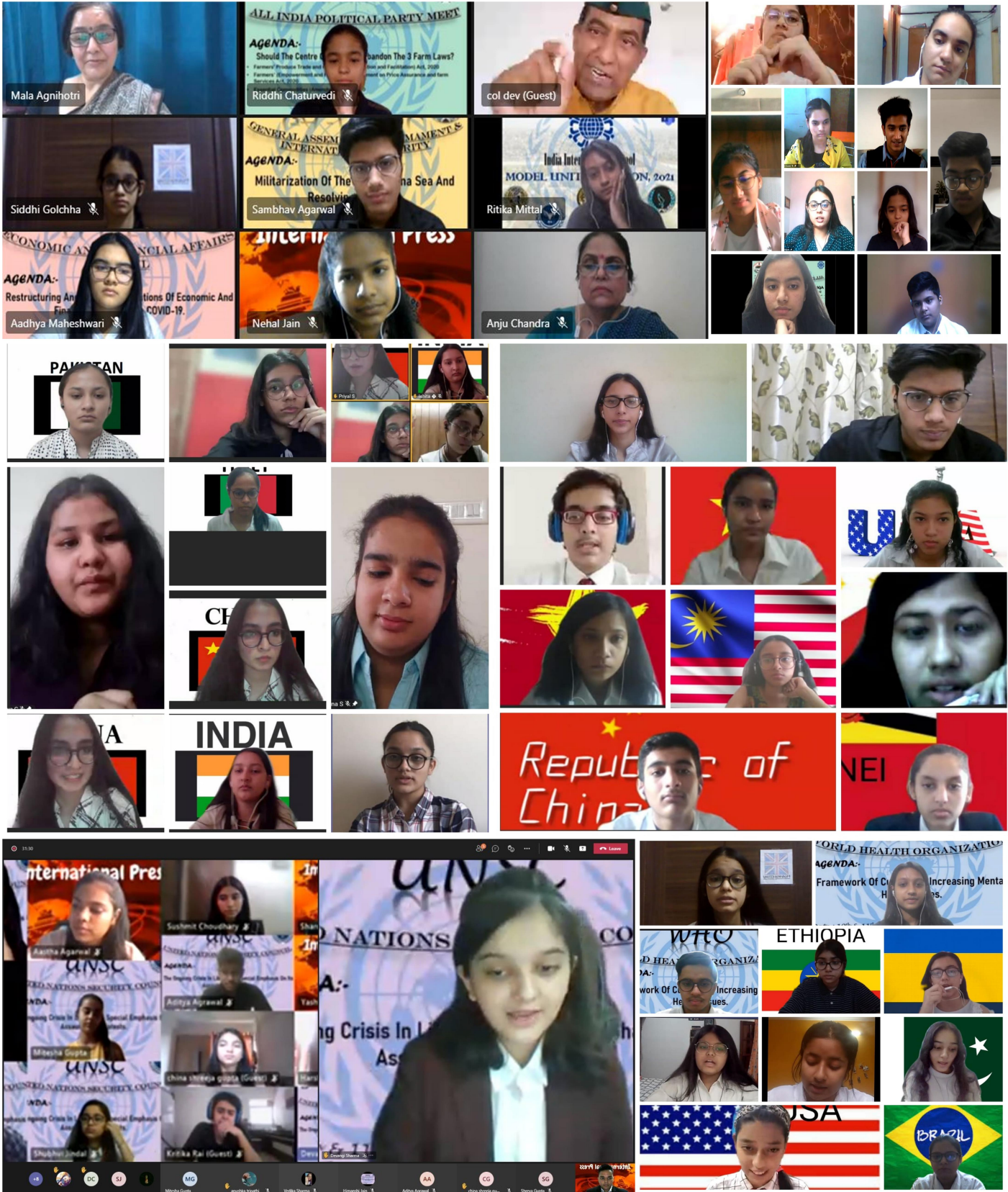


IISMUN '21
