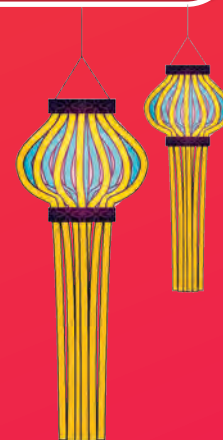
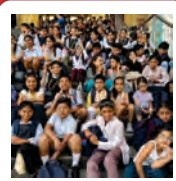
Diwali Craft

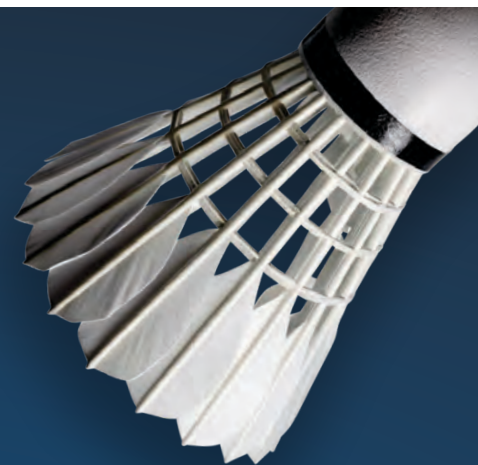

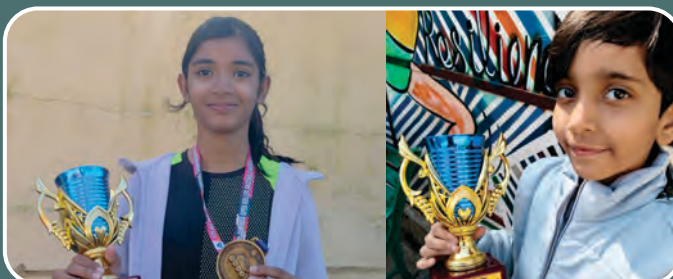
