Mr. Raghuveer Singh shared how he and his team have fought the battles against heinous crimes in the society such as female foeticide.

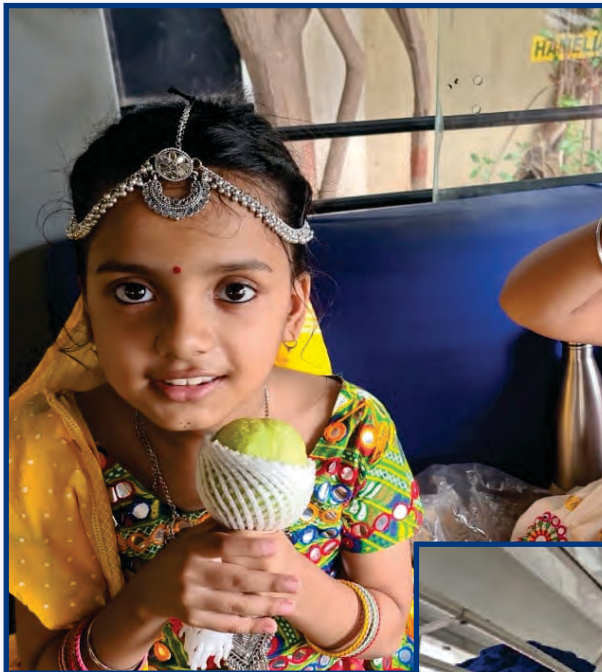

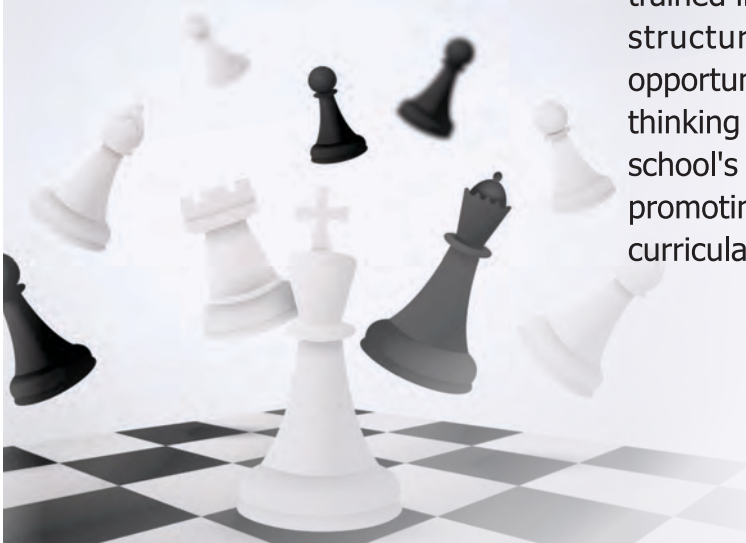


# New at IIS !!

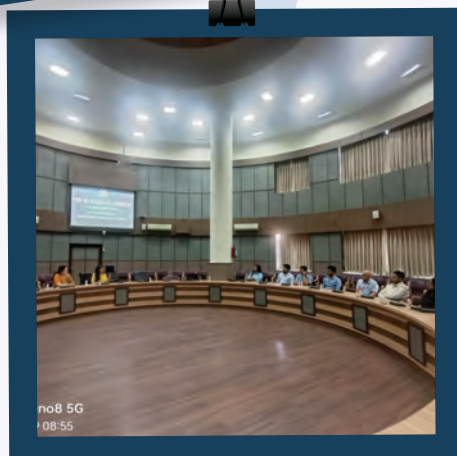

# The Most Cherished Garba

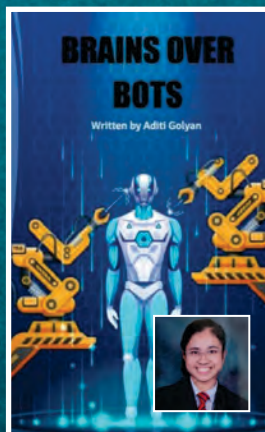
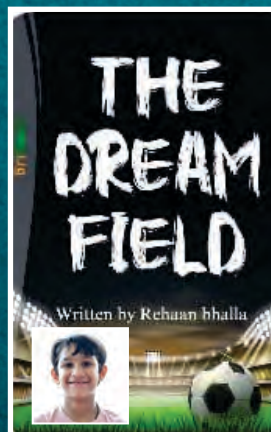
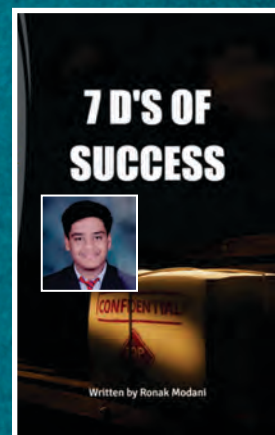
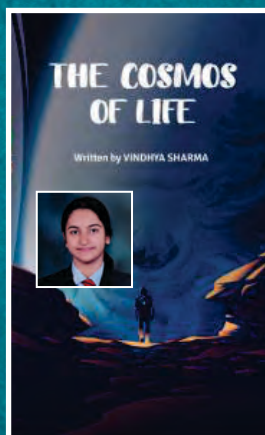

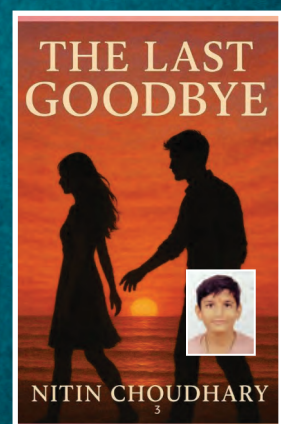
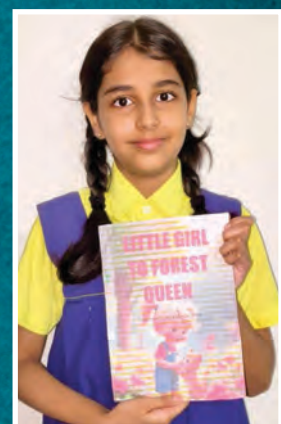
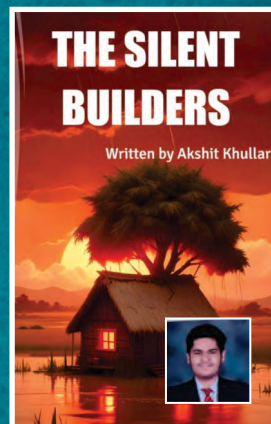
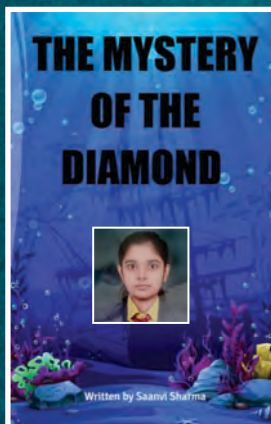
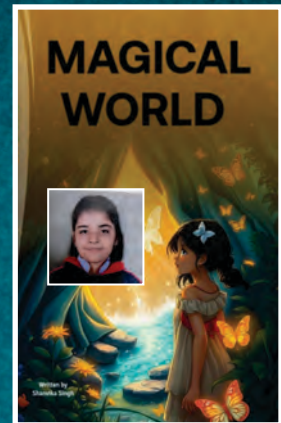
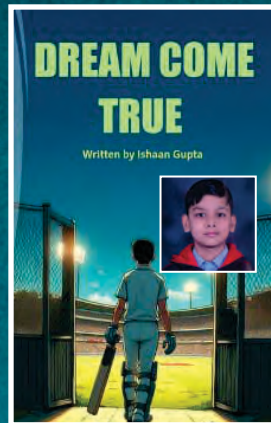
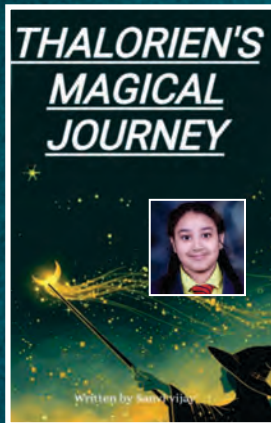


# Early Access Program of the National Young Authors' Fair (NYAF)
